

It's time to register for the Fall 2010 Sports Clinics at Kids' B.A.S.E. This is a new experience for many, so please **read the instructions** below carefully to ensure your child's chance to participate. Fall Clinics are scheduled for **October 4th through December 17th**.

2-4 Lottery Instructions:

Please complete the attached ticket, listing the sports clinic(s) you would like your child enrolled in, in the order of preference.

Your child's name may be entered into the drawing only once. You may mail (at your own risk) or bring the lottery ticket to the KBLS office no later than **3:00pm, Tuesday, August 31, 2010**.

The lottery is conducted on Thursday, September 2, 2010. You will be notified of enrollment by telephone on Tuesday, September 7, 2010 and Wednesday, September 8, 2010 (*a message will be left on your voice mail*). If you do not receive a phone call, your child will be put on the wait list and when a spot becomes available you will be notified. **You will receive Registration forms including a medical form and a Parent Handbook in the mail.**

If your child requires medication at school a Written Medication Consent Form must be completed by your health care provider and yourself.

Children whose names are drawn will have until **5:00 pm, Wednesday, September 15, 2010** to pay the \$220 clinic fee (plus \$60 family registration fee if applicable). **Failure to pay by September 15th and returning appropriate paperwork will result in your child's space being offered to a name on the wait list.** If you do not get your 1st, 2nd, or 3rd choice, you will be wait-listed.

Fall Second through Fourth Grade Kids' B.A.S.E. Sports Clinics with Coach Steve Stone and Coach Paul O'Neal

Monday – Dodge Ball and Soccer Clinic

The sport of Dodge Ball involves players trying to avoid being tagged by a ball that players on the other team are throwing at them. We take a moderate approach by using soft gator skin balls instead of traditional harder rubber balls. The Soccer clinic will teach your child the basic fundamentals of dribbling, shooting, passing, receiving, team play and much more. The first few weeks will be practices and the following weeks will be game time. The skills we will emphasize are proper transferring of weight, hand-eye coordination, running (forwards, backwards, side-to-side) and balance. The children will also learn how to play goalie. These sports will be instructed on a rotating basis.

Tuesday - Basketball and Touch Football Clinic

Clinic classes will focus on teaching the basic fundamentals of Basketball: dribbling, passing, shooting, and defense. The class will also focus on half court team play with team assignments and regulated game play. Touch football is a version of "touch" American football. The two-hand touch variation is the most popular. Team play is emphasized.

Wednesday - All Girls Sports Clinic

This clinic class is for girls only and will focus on teaching the basic fundamentals of soccer, basketball, kickball and softball. Soccer fundamentals such as kicking, trapping, and passing will be instructed, as well as game play. Skills for basketball will include dribbling, shooting and passing.

Thursday – Dodge Ball Clinic

The sport of Dodge Ball involves players trying to avoid being tagged by a ball that players on the other team are throwing at them. We take a moderate approach by using soft gator skin balls instead of traditional harder rubber balls.

Friday – Hockey and Wiffle Ball Clinic

The Hockey Clinic will have the basic skills of shooting, passing, defense and learning how to play goalie. The wiffle ball is also an excellent indoor ball. The wiffle ball is thrown like a baseball and will curve very easily. Experiment with different grips and releases to find the pitches that work best for you. The ball will not travel far when solidly hit. Team play is emphasized.

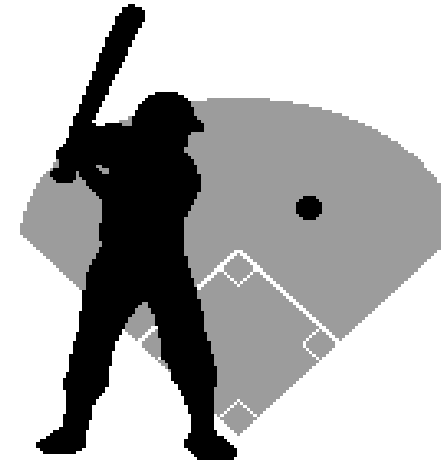

If you are selected for a Sports Clinic you will receive Registration Forms including a medical form and a Parent Handbook in the mail. This lottery ticket is not your registration form.

KBLS SPORTS CLINIC POLICIES

- All children enrolled in the sports clinic must be registered in Kids' B.A.S.E. If selected, the \$220.00 clinic fee, the Kids' B.A.S.E. Registration forms, an up-to-date medical, and Kids' B.A.S.E. \$60 family registration fee for the 2010-2011 school year must be received by K.B.L.S. no later than September 15, 2010.
- Children who do not ride the bus can not be dropped off earlier than 3:30pm. There will be no staff available to supervise the children.
- No CREDITS, REFUNDS or TRANSFERS will be given for absences, weather/emergency closings or WITHDRAWALS from the clinics. There are no Sports Clinics when Kids' B.A.S.E. is closed. On Scarsdale School HALF DAYS, children who normally ride the bus to the clinics, MUST PROVIDE THEIR OWN TRANSPORTATION to Kids' B.A.S.E.
- Included with enrollment and payment, transportation from the Scarsdale schools is provided. Children are also provided with a complimentary hour from 3:30pm-4:30pm of Kids' B.A.S.E. The program remains open until 6:30pm. If you need your child to be here beyond 5:30pm, you need to schedule the additional time and you will be billed accordingly.
- Clinics will not be held on October 11, November 11, 25 and 26, 2010 Always contact Kids' B.A.S.E when your child will be absent or whenever they will not be coming by bus. If your child is absent from Kids' B.A.S.E. without notification you will be billed a \$25.00 fine for each occurrence.

- The Fall Session of sports ends on December 17, 2010. If you need your child to continue to attend Kids' B.A.S.E. for the remainder of the school year, you need to set up a regular schedule for the Kids' B.A.S.E. classroom. Otherwise, his or her name will be dropped from the attendance list.
